Wollongong City SLSC Patrol Guidelines

As part of the Patrol Team you have a basic obligation to:

1. Attend your rostered patrol
2. If you are unable to do so, you must arrange for a substitute to attend in your place. Preferably someone with the same qualifications as yourself. Then return the favour whenever mutually agreeable. If you have any unforeseen problems please contact either Club Captain, or Vice-Captain ASAP and they will try to arrange something.

If you fail to arrange a substitute, club policy states that you are then obliged to:

1. Complete a 4 hour "make-up" patrol, AND
2. Attend a 4 hour "penalty" patrol

Failure to do so will impact your hours and eligibility for 100% Patrol Attendance & associated awards.

100% Patrol attendance will be a minimum of 50 hours as per hours noted in the logbook, entered on Surfguard.

If you swap patrol shifts, send a courtesy text to your Patrol Captain so they know what's going on 😊

NOTE: If the make-up patrol and penalty are not completed before your next rostered patrol then you will be asked to front before the Club Council to explain your actions. This measure is a last resort, but we expect that if you have a rostered patrol, you or a substitute will be there.

- The MINIMUM number of hours for general competitors must not be less than 25 hours for the proceeding calendar year (i.e. 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018).
- The MINIMUM number of hours for competitors falling under the Active Reserve category is 12 hours over the same period.
- Rookies or BJA members wishing to complete at Senior Carnivals MUST ALSO complete the same patrol hour requirements (i.e. 25 Hours).
- Members who only start patrolling this season will only have to complete a percentage, i.e. 12 hours.

It is the competitor's responsibility to maintain their record of their patrol hours.

If you have any questions on your current status of completed patrol hours, your patrol requirements or any other patrol related questions please email or call your Club Captain.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT THE CLUB IN TOTAL CAN BE SUSPENDED FOR THE PATROL DEFAULTS OF INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS.

Patrolling members are reminded to ensure you arrive 10 minutes early to ensure set up/transition is smooth.

Please note: Sometimes patrols are not in numerical order as we have tried to disperse public holiday patrols and Saturday patrols evenly for everyone.

Minimum requirements for patrols

- Approved and inspected equipment as outlined in the Standard Operating Procedures
- Saturday Patrols will require a minimum of 2 x Bronze Medallion Holders, an ATV and radio who will undertake, in liaison with the Council Lifeguards on Duty, roving patrols along the Standard Roving Patrol Area. An IRB is not required.
- Sundays and Public Holidays - 3 x Volunteer Bronze Medallion qualified patrol members, including;
 - 1 x proficient ARTC award holder
 - 1 x proficient IRB Driver
 - 1 x Beach Management award holder
 - 1 x proficient IRB Crew
