Jimmy Murada - father of treasurer Dave, wife Vicki & grandfather to Jarrod & Abby. Jimmy, patriarch of the Murada family & well known transport identity, did not recover from a stroke & ensuing complications shortly after the death of his wife Collen, Judging by the attendance at his funeral service, there were very few truck movements in the Illawarra that day.

Bill Seay OAM - Life Member of SLIllawarra & Port Kembla SLSC & Long Service Member WCSLSC . Known as the `Gentleman Lifesaver`, Bill gave sterling service to his Club & the Branch for 70 years. He also held high office in the Masonic Lodge, was an active committee member of the Illawarra OAM Association & Life Member of Wollongong Whales Winter Swim Club. Bill's service to the community was recognised in the Illawarra Mercury Editorial of 31 August under the headline **A Man of the Sea Leaves a Lasting Legacy.**

Dean Mercer OAM - Champion Lifesaver who, during an illustrious career that started in the `Nipper` ranks, competed for Austinmer, HSP, Thirroul, IMaroochydore & Mooloolaba before taking a senior coaching role at Kurrawa. His outstanding record included:-
4 SLS Australian Titles - 2 Open Iron Man (1989.1995), Open Board Rescue (1988 with brother Darren), Open Board Relay (1990 with Darren & Brett Dowker, 16 SLS NSW Titles, Australian, NSW & QLD Representative, Dual World Oceanman Titles, Dual Test of the Toughest Titles & a number of Kellogg's Nutri Grain & Uncle Tobys's series event wins & placings in 2 Coolangatta Gold campaigns. Dean, aged 47, passed away on the Gold Coast in August from a cardiac arrest while driving home from a surf training session. Our thoughts are with his wife Reen & 4 young sons, parents John & Maureen, brother Darren & family & younger sister Kylie. He gave it all every time he hit the water.

Mitch Elliot – son of John (aka Herb – a member of the 1962 Australian Champion Junior R&R team) & Terry Elliot (both deceased). Mitch had been living in a care home for some years following Herb's death but maintained a close association with the Wollongong Whales who hosted him at the Continental pool on some Sunday pointscore days.

John McMahon – father of 4 boys, 3 of whom (Patrick, Keiran & Ian) were members of our Club at various stages (they were all boaties). Condolences to wife Margaret & family on the passing of a true gentleman.
